Health Science programmes are designed to broaden your knowledge in areas of interdisciplinary health, illness and wellbeing. UNIC provides Foundation pathways into Occupational Therapy, Podiatry, Mental Health Nursing, Adult Nursing and Children's Nursing.

Occupational Therapy

90% of students are in work or further study within 15 months of graduating

Our BSc (Hons) Occupational Therapy degree prepares you to work as a registered occupational therapist in the UK and overseas. Graduates from this course are recognised by the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC) and can register as a member of the Royal College of Occupational Therapists. Students also have the opportunity to take part in a study exchange in Finland.

Podiatry

90% of students are in work or further study within 15 months of graduating

Our BSc (Hons) Podiatry course aims to produce graduates who are fit for practice within the NHS or private sectors and is recognised by the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC). You will benefit from clinical placement and education at our Podiatry Clinic adjacent to Northampton General Hospital and gain hands-on experience at our busy clinics. You will also have the opportunity broaden your experience by doing a three-week placement abroad and attending to injuries at the London marathon.

Nursing

The University of Northampton is ranked **10th in the country for Nursing and Midwifery** in the Best UK University Guardian League table (2021) and consistently achieving a high students' employment rate.

Our Nursing programmes are accredited by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) and the General Dental Council (GDC).

We offer excellent placement opportunities with our NHS and private sector healthcare partners throughout your studies. You will be introduced to a range of care settings to familiarise you with emerging patterns of care and allow you to choose a specialist area within your field of study.

Our Nursing courses are split 50/50 between theory and practical learning, with some of your practical learning taking place during our new clinic skills unit, with **immersive hyperreal simulation equipment.**

- BSc (Hons) Children & Young People's Nursing
