Why choose UNIC?

UNIC is an Associate College of the University of Northampton. We offer academic pathways to a number of undergraduate and postgraduate degrees at the University. If you don't meet the entry criteria to study with the University of Northampton directly, you can choose to study at UNIC before progressing onto your chosen degree course.

Each of our programmes have been carefully designed by academics and education specialists to offer an exciting range of modules related to your chosen degree course. We also have our own Student Services Team and run events and activities so that your experience at UNIC will prepare you both academically and socially for your onward studies.

To keep the application process as simple as possible you will be issued just one CAS and one visa for the entire duration of your course with both UNIC and the University of Northampton. We also offer three intakes a year giving you the flexibility to start your studies at a suitable time for you.

There are three types of pathways on offer; Foundation, First Year and Pre-Master's. Each of these will be explained in this guide including a list of the progression courses available. There is also the option for you to do Pre-sessional English at the university if you do not have the English language qualifications to join UNIC directly.

As a UNIC student you will still have full access to the huge range of facilities that the university has to offer. This includes full access to their brand new Waterside Campus, the Students' Union, library, careers advice, computer facilities and a huge range of sports and social clubs.


Where we are

Your English language preparation.

Studies at UNIC and the University of Northampton are undertaken in English and to gain admission you must be able to demonstrate that you have achieved a suitable level of English language proficiency.

Pre-sessional English

If you do not meet the English requirements for your chosen course, it may be possible to study Pre-sessional English at the University of Northampton before you start your course with UNIC. The programme will help develop your competence and confidence using English in an academic setting.

UNIC offers Pre-sessional English courses, with duration of 6, 11, 17, 28 to 39 weeks.

The classes are taught in the same building as the College, making your transition to UNIC even easier. We organise a welcome lunch in the first few weeks of the course so you can meet other UNIC students.

Upon successful completion of your Pre-sessional English course you will then join your chosen academic programme at UNIC.

Specifically, the course aims to help you to:

- Improve your knowledge of the grammar, vocabulary and functions of English.
- Improve your understanding of the relationship between the language and the culture in which it exists.
- Build your knowledge of and competence in Academic English.
- Take part in social activities and make friends. This will help you to adapt to UK culture.

You will need a UKVI* approved IELTS to apply for the Pre-sessional English and must also hold a UNIC conditional offer letter. Full details of dates, course lengths and fees can be found here:
