Life in Northampton.

Northampton is situated in the very heart of England, just one hour on the train from central London and Birmingham and close to the historic cities of Oxford and Cambridge. Northampton provides students with a bustling urban experience contrasted with a more relaxed, country atmosphere with lots of green space and parkland. It is the second largest town in England with a population of over 215,000.

The town is home to a variety of cultural, sporting and leisure facilities so your child will never be short of things to do and places to see. The town's multicultural population means the town has several international specialist shops and a wealth of restaurants offering a variety of world cuisines. You will also find that large supermarkets will stock a good variety of international ingredients and foods.

NavInsure.

We strongly advise that your child takes out adequate insurance when they travel to the UK to study. This will cover things such as cancellation charges, emergency medical expenses and unforeseen problems as well as personal items.

Navitas offers invaluable cover for international students called NavInsure, which is designed specifically for overseas students, and available for either 12 or 24 months.

Enrolment and Orientation.

If your child is unable to arrive during enrolment week we advise that you let us know as soon as possible so we can put a plan in place to minimise disruption to your child's learning.

There is strong evidence to show that the later you enrol, the harder it is to excel both academically and socially. For this reason, we strongly encourage all students to arrive within the first week of enrolment and not by the last date stated on the Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS).

Accommodation options.

Basset-Lowke Halls of Residence – the most popular option with UNIC students as it is conveniently located directly opposite the College. Every room has an en-suite and the main utility bills for heating, lighting, water and electricity are included within the student's rent.
