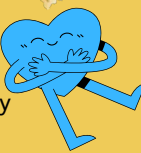

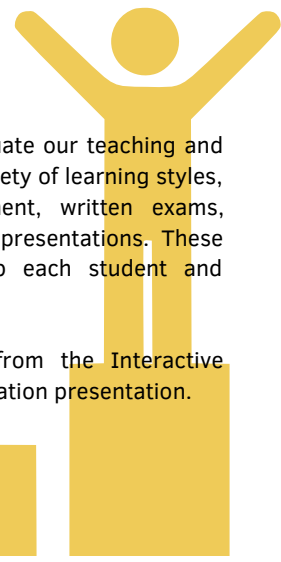




LEARNING STYLES
